
Board Development

Behind the scenes, our board of directors evolved. We intentionally focused on bringing fresh perspectives, and ensuring our leadership reflects the diverse communities we serve.


Implementation of Strategic Plan







Grants:

In December 2023, CYOP received a \$5,000 grant through the Akron Community Foundation's Health and Human Services Grant Cycle to provide inclusive, trauma-informed mental health services to uninsured and underinsured individuals in Summit County.

Volunteer Contributions:

We had a significant increase in our amount of volunteer hours and services in 2023. Between board member service hours, volunteer hours with marketing, administrative work, events, and even in-kind donations of expertise, we obtained \$5,046 worth of volunteer time for the year.


